## Naatahapee! 3

Beginner Go Fish Level 3

## Ooma/Anima/Awa/Ana Practice

Number of players: 2+

Requires: A mix of 8 or more awa and ooma cards (per player)

Object: Try to collect the most matching pairs of cards.

Each player starts with 2 cards in their hand. When you run out of cards, pick up two more.



Choose which question to ask depending on whether your card is awa or ooma:

Player 1: "\_\_\_\_\_, kit-ayaan chiiñ ooma <u>la salaad?"</u>
- or - "\_\_\_\_\_, kit-ayaawaaw chiiñ awa <u>la tomat?"</u>

// (name of Player 2)

## If Player 2 has the card

Player 2: "Wii. Anima la salaad d-ayaan miina." (show the card)

- or - "Wii. Ana la tomat d-ayaawaaw miina." (show the card)

Player 2 gives up the card, then becomes Player 1. (start again at the "Player 1" prompt)

## If Player 2 does not have the card

Player 2: "Noo d-ayaan anima la salaad. Naatahapee!"

- or - "Noo d-ayaawaaw ana la tomat. Naatahapee!"

Player 1 picks up a new card. Player 2 becomes Player 1. (start again at the "Player 1" prompt)

Miyin!

Give it to me! →

Nah!

Here you go!

Marsii!

Thank you!

In this game we are referring to the item on the card and not the card itself.
