Requires: "La Meezooñ" pages (in the "Location" tab) for learning the room names

Object: "Kaa-natonawaat" (the Seeker) tries to find people hiding in different rooms.

Everyone except Kaa-natonawaat hides in different rooms of a house.

Kaa-natonawaat counts to ten out loud in Michif, then goes to different rooms looking for the hiding players. Kaa-natonawaat asks in Michif if anyone is hiding in that room. If someone is hiding in that room and Kaa-natonawaat says the room name correctly, then the one who is hiding needs to make a noise as a hint.
